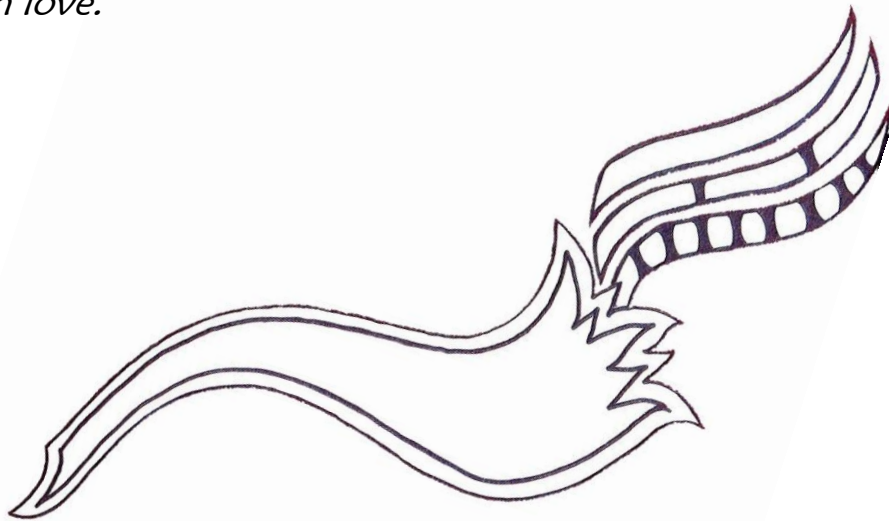
On Rosh Hashanah we praise God who rules and guides the world.
